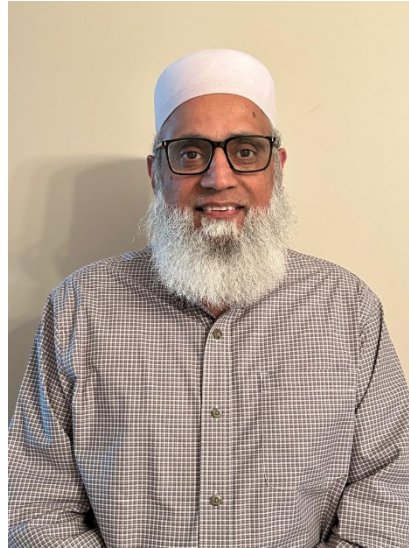


Ijaz Chatha
