- Acute Toxicity



Exploding Bomb

- Explosive



Exclamation Mark

- Acute Toxicity
- Skin or Eye Irritation



Biohazardous

- Biohazardous Infectious Materials



Corrosion

- Skin Corrosion
- Serious Eye Damage



Health Hazard

- Carcinogenicity
- Respiratory Sensitizer



Environment

- (Optional)
- Aquatic Hazards

WHMIS ensures workers know:

- What hazards are present in the workplace
- How to protect themselves
- What to do in an emergency
